INSTRUCTIONAL SPACE UTILIZATION ANALYSIS FALL 2007 SEMESTER

BACKGROUND

This report analyzes instructional space utilization at the University of Arizona using Fall 2007 data. Instructional space for this analysis include class laboratories, classrooms, collaborative/seminar rooms, computer instructional rooms, and lecture halls. The methodology applied for these analyses is based on the Council of Educational Facility Planners, Inc. (CEFPI) <u>Space Planning Guidelines</u>, which were adopted by the Arizona Board of Regents in 1992, and updated and revised in 1997, thereby providing consistent space management guidelines for the three state universities.

This classroom analysis was undertaken to determine the utilization of instructional space for the Fall 2007 semester using enrollment data from the University of Arizona Student Information System's (SIS) 21st day of class audited report for that semester. The results of the analyses are used as an internal management tool for assessing current utilization of instructional space and maximizing the use of existing facilities.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Instructional space utilization for the Fall 2007 semester showed:

- Of the 452,893 student credit hours (SCH) generated in the Fall 2007 semester, 74,992 SCH were not included in this analysis due to them being attributed to independent studies, evening courses, weekend courses, and/or courses which took place off campus. 377,901 SCH were accounted for in this analysis, equating to 409,300 weekly student contact hours (WSCH).
- 4,230 courses were held each week, in 587 rooms, in 88 different university buildings totaling 568,641 Net Assignable Square Feet (NASF).
- 3,853 courses were held each week, in 436 instructional rooms.
- 393,491 weekly student contact hours transpired in instructional space.
- Classes taught averaged 35 students per class.
- Only six percent of the courses taught during the Fall 2007 semester contained 100 or more students (249 of the 4,230 total courses).
- 71% of all classes held 29 or fewer students as compared to 72% for the previous year.
- Data indicates a substantially lower utilization of departmentally controlled rooms, especially computer classrooms and lecture halls.
- Data indicates a shortage of rooms with a capacity less than 29, where the demand is greatest. Conversely, data shows a surplus
 of rooms with a capacity greater than 40, resulting in an underutilization of larger rooms.

The analyses in this report classify the 587 rooms into six room type categories:

TOTAL INSTRUCTIONAL ROOMS

The Room and Course Scheduling department controls scheduling for the majority (approx. 90%) of the University's classrooms and lecture halls, but departments are responsible for scheduling virtually all of the class laboratories and seminar rooms. Room classifications in the non-instructional category include conference rooms, meeting rooms, offices, reading rooms, and research labs.

INSTRUCTIONAL SPACE UTILIZATION ANALYSIS FALL 2007 SEMESTER

INTRODUCTION

This classroom analysis was undertaken to determine the utilization of instructional space for the Fall 2007 semester using enrollment data from the University of Arizona Student Information System's (SIS) 21st day of class audited report for this semester. The results of the analysis are used as an internal management tool for assessment of current utilization of instructional space and maximizing the use of existing facilities.

METHODOLOGY

The Council of Educational Facility Planners, Inc. (CEFPI) <u>Space Planning Guidelines</u> methodology was applied. Revised CEFPI guidelines were adopted by the Arizona Board of Regents (ABOR) Space Management Committee in fiscal year 1997-98.

The three major factors examined in these analyses were:

- 1) the average hours of instruction per week in each room,
- 2) the average number of student stations occupied during those classes, and
- 3) the net assignable square feet (NASF) per student station.

REPORT ORGANIZATION

This report is divided into sections for easy use and cross-referencing. The first section is devoted to summary information, charts and graphs. The second section addresses space by buildings; the reader will find information about room use by building, as well as by room classification. The final section reports on utilization of rooms by the room type categories, i.e., classrooms, collaborative/seminar rooms, computer instructional classrooms, lecture halls, class laboratories. A glossary is included to clarify the terms used in the report. Any questions should be directed to Real Estate Administration at 621-1813.

<u>CLASSROOMS:</u> The first factor focuses on average scheduled hours of instruction held per week for classrooms. According to ABOR guidelines, any classroom that is not being scheduled for 35 hours per week is considered underutilized. Utilization of centrally scheduled classrooms is substantially higher than that of departmentally scheduled rooms. The 173 centrally scheduled classrooms averaged 31 hours of instruction per week compared to the departments' 24 classrooms scheduled for an average of 20 hours per week.

The second factor analyzes whether or not the size of the class enrollment is appropriate to the capacity of a particular room. ABOR guidelines recommend an average station occupancy rate of 65% as a minimum utilization standard. Centrally scheduled classrooms averaged 64% vs. 59% occupancy for departmentally scheduled classrooms.

The third factor analyzes the net assignable square feet (NASF) per student station, which reflects the amount of square footage utilized for each student station. It is calculated by dividing the room size by the seating capacity. For this report, ABOR standard of 19 NASF per student station is used for classrooms. Centrally scheduled classrooms averaged 17 NASF per student station, while departmentally scheduled classrooms averaged 24 NASF. Overall, the report reflects a very efficient NASF per student station ratio. This may be due to the fact that the University of Arizona historically programmed its buildings for 15 NASF per student station, while current Arizona Board of Regents/CEFPI recommendation is 19 NASF. The increase is due to additional space requirements for audiovisual equipment and ADA access.

COLLABORATIVE/SEMINAR ROOMS

Collaborative/seminar rooms are distinguished by the presence of tables and chairs and a typical room capacity of fewer than 30 stations. ABOR guidelines call for 35 hours of scheduled classes each week, with at least 67% of the available seats filled. Departments utilized their seminar rooms, on average, for 15 hours each week at 78% occupancy, while centrally scheduled rooms averaged 26 hours and 76% occupancy. The standard NASF per student station under ABOR guidelines is 22 square feet. Centrally scheduled collaborative rooms averaged 19 NASF per student station, while departmentally scheduled rooms averaged 25 NASF per station.

COMPUTER INSTRUCTIONAL CLASSROOMS

Computer instructional classrooms are distinguished from other types of classrooms by the presence of computers at each student workstation. ABOR guidelines call for an average of 32 weekly class hours and an occupancy level of 75%. All computer instructional classrooms were departmentally scheduled. Departments utilized their rooms, on average, for 14 hours each week at 85% occupancy. The standard NASF per student station under ABOR guidelines is 32 square feet. The departmentally scheduled rooms averaged 38 NASF per student station.

<u>LECTURE HALLS:</u> Lecture halls are distinguished by their "auditorium" type, fixed seating arrangements, and their larger seating capacities. The 36 lecture halls controlled by Room and Course Scheduling were in use an average of 27 hours per week, with an average occupancy rate of 80%. The six departmentally scheduled lecture halls which were used an average of 15 hours per week at an occupancy rate of 43%. ABOR guidelines call for an average of 32 weekly class hours and an occupancy level of 63%. The standard student station size for lecture halls under the guidelines is 17 square feet. Departmentally scheduled lecture halls averaged 14 NASF per student station and centrally scheduled lecture halls averaged 12 NASF per student station, both below ABOR guidelines.


CLASS LABORATORIES

The materials and specialized teaching equipment and times necessary to support class labs varies from discipline to discipline, which requires individual departments to schedule use of these rooms. Class labs are divided into three subcategories: lab types A, B, and C. The ABOR guidelines for Type A labs (such as business and social sciences) are 25 weekly class hours at an occupancy of 85%. For type B labs (physical and biological sciences) the ABOR guidelines are 22.5 weekly class hours at 85% occupancy. Type C labs (such as engineering, agriculture and health sciences) characteristically have the greatest space needs due to the specialized equipment and the considerable amount of independent laboratory work required by the disciplines. ABOR standards call for type C labs to be used 12.5 hours per week at 85% occupancy.

Type A class labs did not meet class hour standards in 2007. There was an average of 16 weekly class hours, while average station occupancy was 72%. Type B labs averaged 20 hours per week of utilization and occupancy level of 83%. Type C labs surpassed the weekly class hour standard, with 20 hours of utilization a week, but average occupancy was low at 50%.

NON-INSTRUCTIONAL ROOMS: There were 151 locations not covered by CEFPI guidelines which were used for instruction during Fall 2007. These rooms generated 15,809 WSCH. Among the rooms included in this category are: conference rooms, research labs and their associated service rooms.





Number of Instructional Rooms by Room Type ¹






Net Assignable Square Feet (NASF) of Instructional Rooms by Room Type 1







Weekly Student Contact Hours (WSCH) in Instructional Rooms by Room Type ¹










Number of Classes by Time and Day¹ - Tuesday and Thursday²







Enrollment by Time and Day 1- Monday, Wednesday and Friday



GLOSSARY FOR INSTRUCTIONAL SPACE UTILIZATION ANALYSIS

CLASSROOMS:

Instructional rooms that may have traditional tablet arm chair configuration or narrow table and chair configuration, to provide added student work surface. Room capacities typically range from 30 to 100 stations.

COLLABORATIVE/SEMINAR ROOMS:

Classrooms with movable tables and chairs which provide the instructor flexibility to arrange a class in small discussion teams or to meet with the class as a whole. This category also includes seminar rooms, which typically have conference style seating. Room capacities are typically fewer than 30 stations.

COMPUTER INSTRUCTIONAL CLASSROOMS:

Classrooms or class labs equipped with computer terminals at each student station, providing students the ability to individually access class materials stored on computer files. The rooms are typically equipped with desktop computers which support the technology requirements for courses in a broad range of academic disciplines.

LECTURE HALLS:

Classrooms for large classes with either fixed tables and/or chairs or traditional theater type seating. Room capacities typically exceed 100 stations.

NASF/STUDENT STATION:

The number of square feet used to accommodate one student in the particular room type and/or discipline being evaluated. Net assignable square feet (NASF) per student station is calculated by dividing the total room square footage by the number of student stations (capacity) in that room.

NASF/STUDENT STATION STANDARD:

The number of square feet per individual student recommended by Council of Educational Facility Planners, International (CEFPI) for instructional purposes. Class lab standard sizes are determined by discipline.

PERCENT STATIONS OCCUPIED WHEN SCHEDULED:

The percentage of student stations occupied during scheduled classes. The number of occupied student stations is divided by the number of available student stations (capacity).

STUDENT STATIONS:

The number of chairs or seats available in the room. Also referred to as "capacity."

TOTAL WEEKLY STUDENT STATION DEMAND:

The number of students enrolled in a class, multiplied by the number of class sections per week.

WEEKLY CLASS HOURS:

The number of hours a room is used for scheduled classes each week. This figure does not include any tutoring, conferences, meetings or other activities which may occur in a room.

WEEKLY STUDENT CONTACT HOURS (WSCH):

A unit of measure which represents one hour of instruction given to one student in one week.

The data source for this analysis is the Fall Semester 2007 registration data from the University of Arizona Student Information System (SIS).

Standards used within this document are from <u>Space Planning Guidelines</u>, Council of Educational Facility Planners, International, July 1985, as revised and adopted by the Arizona Board of Regents' Space Management Committee.
